


HENRY THE HEDGEHOG

 4-ply  4mm
★ **New techniques**

Yarn used

Kit yarn
beige (MC)
dark brown (CC1)
orange (CC2)
light brown (CC3)
cream (CC4)

About the yarn

4-ply; 400m per 100g;
100% acrylic

Tension

24 sts = 10cm
Stitches should be tight
enough to avoid stuffing
showing through

Hook used

4mm

Other supplies

2 black safety eyes, 7mm

Sizing

10cm long

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This pattern is worked in
the amigurumi style, in a
spiral without slip stitching or
turning chains.

Head & Body

Rnd 1: With CC1 and working
into a magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: Dc around.

Rnd 3: Change to MC, dc
around. 6 sts

Rnd 4: [2 dc in next st] twice,
dc to end. 8 sts

Rnd 5: 1 dc, [2 dc in next st]
twice, dc to end. 10 sts

Rnd 6: 2 dc, [2 dc in next st]
twice, dc to end. 12 sts

Rnd 7: 3 dc, [2 dc in next st],
twice, dc to end. 14 sts

Rnd 8: 4 dc, [2 dc in next st],
twice, dc to end. 16 sts

Rnd 9: 5 dc, [2 dc in next st],
twice, dc to end. 18 sts

Rnd 10: 6 dc, [2 dc in next
st], twice, dc to end. 20 sts

Rnd 11: 7 dc, [2 dc in next
st], twice, dc to end. 22 sts

Rnd 12: 8 dc, [2 dc in next
st], twice, dc to end. 24 sts

Rnd 13: [2 dc in next st, 3
dc] 6 times. 30 sts

Rnds 14-21: Dc around.

Rnd 22: [1 dc2tog, 3 dc] 6
times. 24 sts

Rnds 23-24: Dc around.

Rnd 25: [1 dc2tog, 2 dc] 6
times. 18 sts

Rnd 26: Dc around.
Add safety eyes near the
nose and stuff head.

Rnd 27: [1 dc2tog, 1 dc] 6
times. 12 sts

Rnd 28: 6 dc2tog. 6 sts
Finish stuffing body.

Fasten off leaving long
end and use to sew the
end closed.

Tummy

With CC4,
chain 4.

Rnd 1: Starting in 2nd
ch from hook, 2 dc, 3 dc in

last st, turning as you go,
work into the other side of
the chain, 1 dc, 2 dc in last
st. 8 sts

Rnd 2: 2 dc in first st, 1 dc,
[2 dc in next st] 3 times, 1
dc, [2 dc in next st] twice.
14 sts

Rnd 3: 2 dc in first st, 2 dc, [2
dc in next st, 1 dc] 3 times,
1 dc, [2 dc in next st, 1 dc]
twice. 20 sts

Rnd 4: 2 dc in first st, 3 dc, [2
dc in next st, 2 dc] 3 times,
1 dc, [2 dc in next st, 2 dc]
twice. 26 sts

Rnd 5: 2 dc in first st, 4 dc, [2
dc in next st, 3 dc] 3 times,
1 dc, [2 dc in next st, 3 dc]
twice. 32 sts

Fasten off and sew to body.

Feet (make 4)

Rnd 1: With CC1 and
working into a magic ring,
6 dc.

Rnds 2-3: Dc around.

Rnds 4-6: Change to MC,
dc around.

Fasten off.





Spikes

Using the Spike Motif pattern make:

- 69 continuous spikes in CC3
- 55 continuous spikes in CC2
- 7 individual spikes in CC1

Making up

Sew spikes onto hedgehog's back, alternating rows of 6 spikes in CC3 followed by 5 spikes in CC2 **1**, **2** until the whole back is filled, the last few rows of spikes will be shorter. Use pins to hold

first row in place to get the right position **3**, **4**, then secure it with short stitches in-between the triangles **5**, there's no need to sew down the whole strip and it'll be done quicker!

Add the 7 individual spikes in CC1 randomly throughout the back.

Sew feet to bottom of body around the tummy to complete. **6**



Yarn and Colours

Must-Have is a fab yarn for crochet, and the range of colours is a delight – you can even buy mini-balls! Try these colours:

Limestone 009 (MC) (15g),
Brownie 025 (CC1) (5g),
Sorbus 019 (CC2) (10g),
Chestnut 024 (CC3) (10g),
cream 002 (CC4) (5g)

Chart




- O chain (ch)
- X double crochet (dc)
- T half treble crochet (htr)
- ⌣ treble crochet (tr)

Stitch pattern

Spike Motif: Chain 4.

Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr, *4 ch, starting in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr; rep from * needed number of times.



The nose of the hedgehog is shaped with the increases. Sometimes the pieces twist when you're making them, to fix this, gently reshape the toy once stuffed
